

## Milligan MBA Financial Aid Information

***If you plan to apply for Financial Aid and have questions or need assistance, please contact Student Financial Services: [SFS@milligan.edu](mailto:SFS@milligan.edu) or 423.461.8949 and ask to speak to a Student Financial Services counselor. This person will remain your counselor throughout the program, and you should contact them with any specific questions you may have.***

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) forms for 2008-09 is available. You must apply for federal financial aid *each* year. The basic steps for applying for financial aid at Milligan College are below:

1. Before beginning FAFSA, apply for a pin # at: [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov). This process usually takes 48 – 72 hours.
2. Gather information to help you complete the FAFSA (If you like, use the *FAFSA On the Web* worksheet at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).) Helpful information to have on hand includes:
  - Social Security #
  - Drivers License #
  - Tax information for the year prior to the academic year for which you are applying. (including W2 for yourself and spouse if applicable)
  - Records of any untaxed income (i.e. veterans benefits)
  - Information on savings, investments, and other assets
3. Complete FAFSA application at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). Make sure you receive a confirmation number after you submit the application.
4. Complete and submit the *Milligan College* Financial Aid Application to the Student Financial Services Office (this must be in your file before you can receive financial aid at Milligan). This form is available at [www.milligan.edu/sfs](http://www.milligan.edu/sfs). You may also request this form by contacting your Student Financial Services Counselor. Please remind your Counselor that you need the form for graduate students.
5. Follow up on your FAFSA. You should receive a report (SAR) by email and/or by regular mail. If you do not receive the SAR within 3 weeks of applying, go to the website and check your status. Review the SAR for any corrections needed.
6. When your FAFSA is processed, Milligan will receive the information regarding your financial aid status. Once you receive acceptance into the MBA program you will receive notification from Milligan College of your Financial Aid award.

### General Information

- If you are planning a September 2008 Start:
  - Fill out 2008 – 2009 FAFSA for semesters 1 & 2
  - Fill out 2009 – 2010 FAFSA for semesters 3 & 4
- Milligan's school code (for FAFSA) is 003511
- Financial Aid may be available for pre-requisite undergraduate course work. You must be enrolled at least half time to be eligible for aid. Aid for prerequisite coursework is only available for a 12 month period. Please check with Student Financial Services to determine eligibility.
