

MSOT Student Outcomes

The following data is reported as an aggregate for the three most recent calendar years for the Milligan College MSOT program graduates for the class of 2006, 2007 & 2008 as of July 30, 2009:

Student outcomes:

1. Total Number of Program Graduates: **65**
2. Total number of first time test takers: **58 (as of July 30, 2009)**
3. Overall percentage of test takers who passed the exam: **100%**
4. Total number of *first time test takers* who passed the exam: **52 (as of July 30, 2009)**
5. Percentage of the total number of *first-time test takers* who passed the exam: **90%**
6. Graduate job placement rate: **100% within three to six months of graduation**
7. Average starting full-time salary for 2008 graduates: **\$60,000-\$65,000**

Student satisfaction with the program:

7. Overall student satisfaction: **100% of alumni either agreed or strongly agreed that they were satisfied with how the program prepared them for their career in occupational therapy.**
8. Theory and practice: **100% of alumni either agreed or strongly agreed that the program provided them with a sound base of theoretical knowledge and practical skills as an entry-level therapist.**
9. Servant leadership: **100% of alumni agreed or strongly agreed that the program prepared them to participate as a servant leader in the field of occupational therapy.**
