**TRANSFER AGREEMENT (NURSING) BETWEEN
NORTHEAST STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE
and MILLIGAN COLLEGE**

Updated 11-2009

This transfer agreement between Northeast State Community College and Milligan College will facilitate access for Northeast State Community College students who desire to transfer to Milligan College.

The agreement consists of two parts: Terms of Agreement and Implementation Procedures.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

1. Northeast State Community College graduates who have completed the Associate of Arts or the Associate of Science degree program in accordance with the Northeast State Community College-Milligan College Advisory Tracks will be admitted to Milligan College and be granted junior status.

The university parallel Associate of Science degree program with emphasis in Nursing is accepted for transfer by Milligan College, which offers a bachelor's degree program in the field of nursing. While pursuing the Associate of Science degree, students will take two semesters of dual enrollment courses (NURS 202/202L; 210/210C; 220/220C) at Milligan College. These courses are to be taken in the fall and spring semesters or in two summer sessions immediately prior to matriculation to the BSN program at Milligan College. Students should plan to take Biology 1230, 2010, and 2020 at NSCC as early in their academic programs as possible in order to meet pre/co-requisite requirements for the dual enrollment nursing courses.

The university parallel Associate of Science degree program for the LPN to RN student is accepted for transfer by Milligan College, which offers a bachelor's degree program in the field of nursing. While pursuing the Associate of Science degree, students will take one semester of dual enrollment courses (NURS 201/201C; 202/202L) at Milligan College. These courses are to be taken in the spring semester immediately prior to matriculation to the BSN program at Milligan College. Students should plan to take Biology 1230, 2010, and 2020 at NSTCC as early in their academic programs as possible in order to meet pre/co-requisite requirements for the dual enrollment nursing courses.

2. Students not completing an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree at Northeast State Community College will have their transcripts evaluated on a course by course basis using the current edition of the Northeast State Community College-Milligan College Equivalency Guide.
3. Northeast State Community College graduates who have used credits earned at other accredited institutions to satisfy their degree requirements at Northeast State will have those credits validated at Northeast State Community College.

4. Students will be required to satisfy major program requirements as stipulated in the Northeast State Community College-Milligan College catalogs in effect at the time of their initial enrollment at Northeast State Community College. Students will have seven years from their initial Northeast State Community College enrollment until the completion of all requirements for the baccalaureate degree. If more than seven years elapse, the agreement in place at that time will determine the status of the transfer students.
5. This agreement will commence September 1, 2009, and continue on a year-to-year basis.
6. Milligan College accepts for transfer only those courses in which the student has earned grades of C- and higher. For transfer courses, only the credit hours are posted to the student's Milligan transcript. No grades are recorded for transferred credit.

Nursing students must earn a grade no lower than C in the following courses for the courses to meet the requirements for the Nursing major at Milligan College:

6. Students transferring in composition credits must prepare a writing essay before the start of the semester. If the students need to improve their writing skills, they must enroll in COMP 111. The transferred composition credit will be treated as elective credits under these circumstances.
7. When credit hours for equivalent courses do not match, the difference in hours shall be taken from or used toward elective hours.
