### **DEPART NEW YORK**

#### **SUNDAY, MAY 20**

Your exciting adventure begins as you depart New York on board your overnight transatlantic jet flight to Barcelona.

### **ARRIVE BARCELONA**

#### **MONDAY, MAY 21**

Today you arrive in cosmopolitan Barcelona, Spain, the cultural and political center of Catalonia and Spain's most European city. The city is divided into two sections: The Gothic Quarter symbolizes the older part and its wide avenues distinguish the more modern section. Upon arrival, enjoy a tour of the city. Highlights include the Gothic Quarter, the world famous Cathedral and the Holy Family Church, "La Sagrada Familia" by Gaudi.

### **BARCELONA/EMBARK SHIP**

#### **TUESDAY, MAY 22**

Today you transfer to the pier for embarkation on the luxurious *NORWEGIAN SPIRIT*. NCL's ship shines from bow to stern with an incredible array of amenities including many distinct restaurants, numerous bars and lounges, swimming pools, spa and more. **(B,D)**

### **TOULON (PROVENCE)**

#### **WEDNESDAY, MAY 23**

Located in the Provence-Alpes-Cote d'Azur region in southern France, Toulon is the capital of the Var department in the former province of Provence. Here you can walk around this

charming town adorned with small squares, fountains, quaint shops and cafes. **(B,L,D)**

### **LIVORNO (FLORENCE)**

#### **THURSDAY, MAY 24**

Arrive this morning in Livorno, the gateway to Pisa, famous for its "Leaning Tower", and Florence, the cradle of Renaissance Art and former stronghold of the infamous Medici family. From Botticelli to Da Vinci, Florence is unsurpassed in art treasures and the glory of its history. Opportunity to take a tour of the city or visit the Academia to see Michelangelo's original statue of David. **(B,L,D)**

### **CIVITAVECCHIA (ROME)**

#### **FRIDAY, MAY 25**

From the port of Civitavecchia you have the chance to visit Rome and Vatican City. On optional sightseeing tours you can see the wonderful art treasures in the Vatican Museum and Gallery and Raphael's Rooms. View Michelangelo's exquisite frescoes in the Sistine Chapel, including the famous Last Judgment and The Creation of Man, and visit St. Peter's Basilica. Other popular sites include the romantic Trevi Fountain and the Colosseum, where Christians were once thrown to the lions. **(B,L,D)**

## NAPLES

### SATURDAY, MAY 26

Today you arrive in Naples where you can visit Pompeii, a city destroyed by the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in the year 70 A.D., the isle of Capri or drive along the magnificent Amalfi Coast with its spectacular views of the Mediterranean to the cliff-top town of Sorrento. (B,L,D)

## AT SEA

### SUNDAY, MAY 27

What a great opportunity today to explore all the *NORWEGIAN SPIRIT* has to offer - where, from sunrise to sunset the decks and public rooms abound with an endless variety of activities. (B,L,D)

## MYKONOS

### MONDAY, MAY 28

Arrive at Mykonos, a great favorite with its endless winding streets leading to scenic harbors or deserted sandy coves. This island is most famous for its white-washed windmills and 365 tiny churches with their brightly colored domes. (B,L,D)

## ISTANBUL

### TUESDAY, MAY 29

Today you arrive at Istanbul, ancient Constantinople. Here you may visit the Topkapi Palace, home of the Ottoman Sultans and see the Treasury containing jewel-encrusted thrones, the world's largest emerald and the famous Topkapi dagger. Chance to see St. Sophia, originally a Christian Basilica or visit the legendary Blue Mosque with six minarets and a middle dome of 109 feet. Be sure to stop at the Grand Bazaar, a labyrinth of over 4,000 shops displaying everything from souvenirs in copper and onyx to precious jewelry, antiques and Oriental carpets. (B,L,D)

## IZMIR(EPHESUS)

### WEDNESDAY, MAY 30

Arrive Izmir, an archaeologically-rich city dating back 5,000 years. From Izmir, you can take an optional sightseeing tour to the magnificent city of Ephesus where St. Paul lived and preached. Here you may walk the marble streets or choose to see the fabled Temple of Artemis, another

Wonder of the Ancient World, the Stadium and the Library of Celsus. (B,L,D)

## ATHENS

### THURSDAY, MAY 31

Arrive in Piraeus this morning, the port for Athens. Take an optional sightseeing tour or spend the day independently exploring the "birthplace of democracy" including the Olympic Stadium, the Temple of Zeus, or the Parthenon with the Temple of Diana. Shop in the afternoon in the Plaka or stop at a sidewalk cafe to enjoy a Greek specialty. (B,L,D)

## AT SEA

### FRIDAY, JUNE 1

Opportunity today to participate in your ship's numerous activities and amenities. Get a massage or take a fitness class... attend an art auction...unwind in one of the whirlpool spas or simply lounge on deck and soak in the wonderful passing scenery. (B,L,D)

# GENERAL CONDITIONS

## RESERVATIONS, DEPOSITS & FINAL PAYMENT:

Reservations may be secured upon payment of a deposit of \$600 per person. No reservation is considered firm until deposit has been received. Your initial deposit payment shall be deemed to be an acceptance of all the terms of our General Conditions. Final payment is due at Nawas Travel 100 days prior to departure date.

Nawas accepts Visa, Mastercard and American Express for balance/final payments only. Credit cards are not accepted for deposits. The price of the tour already includes a built-in discount of 3% for payments made by cash or check. There is no discount on credit card sales. Credit cards will only be accepted prior to the final payment due date. Credit card charges cannot be accepted over the telephone. Tour members who want to use a credit card for final payment should contact Nawas at the time final payment is due for further information.

**TRAVEL DOCUMENTS:** A U.S.A. passport valid for 6 months after date of re-entry into the U.S.A. is required. (Non U.S.A. citizens may require visas in addition to a valid passport.) It is the responsibility of each passenger to check with the respective consulate(s) of the countries to be visited or a visa agency to determine whether they have the proper visa/travel documents for their tour.

## THE TOUR PRICE INCLUDES:

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** By any IATAN/ARC or other scheduled jet carrier, in economy class, with flights and air routings at the discretion of the air carriers and Nawas and based on non-refundable bulk group fares. Cancellations made after air tickets have been issued are subject to full cancellation penalties as imposed by the airlines. We strongly recommend all tour members retain both their ticket receipts and boarding passes as copies of same cannot be provided. Airline tickets must bear your first, middle and last name as it appears on your passport.

**SURFACE TRANSPORTATION:** By deluxe motorcoach.

**CRUISE ACCOMMODATIONS:** Cruise accommodations are based on two persons sharing a twin bedded cabin with two lower beds and private facilities. A large variety of superior state rooms are available at supplementary costs (see price information). A person taking a single cabin (subject to availability) must pay a supplement. The supplement for a single cabin is available upon request. Nawas cannot guarantee roommates.

**HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS:** Accommodations are at first class hotels based on two persons sharing a twin bedded room with private bath. A person taking a single room (subject to availability) must pay a supplement. The supplement for a single room is available upon request.

**MEALS:** All meals on board the cruiseship. Continental breakfast only in Barcelona and Venice.

**SIGHTSEEING:** Shore excursions are not included. They must be registered for in advance and paid for at the ship's Shore Excursion Desk once on board. Shore excursions cannot be prepaid.

**TRANSFERS:** Assistance and transfers to/from airports/piers/hotels are included.

**SERVICE CHARGES, TAXES AND PORTERAGE:** Service charges and taxes normally included in bills, government taxes on hotel bills in effect on July 11, 2011, taxes on sightseeing and excursion trips and portage at hotels of one normal size suitcase (maximum weight 50 lbs.) are included in the tour price.

**FLIGHT INSURANCE:** Automatic one hundred thousand dollars flight insurance policy for each Nawas-ticketed passenger, subject to policy terms and limitations.

**DEVIATIONS:** All deviation requests from the group itinerary must be received at Nawas in writing no later than 100 days prior to departure. A \$100 non refundable fee per person will be charged on all deviations in addition to any extra airfare that may be incurred. Air deviations are

subject to availability and restrictions as imposed by the airlines.

**BAGGAGE:** Airlines may now charge baggage fees for checked luggage on international/domestic flights based on the policy of each carrier. The maximum number of pieces of luggage, the weight allowance and baggage dimensions may also vary by airline from the USA to overseas destinations and beyond. Many carriers require that checked luggage in economy class not exceed 50 lbs with a combined length, width and height of 62 inches. Regulations vary for business/first class passengers. Airline policies regarding baggage are subject to change at any time without prior notice. It is the responsibility of each passenger to check with their airline prior to departure for baggage information, regulations and compliance. Nawas is not responsible for additional fees imposed by air carriers regarding baggage. Due to space limitations on Nawas motorcoaches, Nawas can only allow one piece of luggage per person plus a carry-on bag with total dimensions of 45 inches which fits in the overhead bin or underneath the seat in front of you. Wheeled carry-on bags are not permitted due to limited motorcoach capacity. Nawas Travel accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to the tour members' baggage or personal belongings at any time. Baggage insurance is recommended and is available upon written request.

## TRAVELERS REQUIRING SPECIAL ASSISTANCE:

Disabled travelers requiring special attention or care must advise NAWAS in writing at the time of reservation. A physically able companion must accompany any person who needs special assistance. Tour directors, guides, drivers or other tour, hotel or ship personnel are not able to provide such assistance. NAWAS is not responsible for any denial of services to the disabled participant by air carriers, cruise ships, hotels, restaurants or other independent suppliers. Certain countries/destinations involve extensive walking. Be aware that outside the U.S. the Americans with Disabilities Act is not applicable and facilities for disabled individuals are limited. NAWAS is not responsible for any passenger requiring special medical equipment.

## THE TOUR PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

Cruise government taxes/fees (currently \$157), U.S. departure taxes, airline security fees/surcharges and fuel surcharges (taxes/surcharges currently estimated at \$500 to \$575 per person depending on the airline used), cruise fuel surcharges (if any), any other overseas airport & local government taxes, passport fees, visa fees (if any), shore excursions, portage at piers, phone calls, valet/laundry service, wines, liquors, mineral water, after dinner coffee or tea, tips to guides, drivers, cruise personnel, etc. and other services not specifically mentioned, excess baggage, and all other items of a purely personal nature.

**CANCELLATIONS:** For written cancellations received by Nawas Travel up to January 20, 2012, refunds will be made less a \$200 per person cancellation fee. From January 21, 2012 to 80 days prior to departure, written cancellations received by Nawas Travel are subject to a \$600 per person cancellation fee. From 79 to 35 days prior to departure, written cancellations received by Nawas Travel are subject to a cancellation fee of 50% of the total tour price per person. From 34 days prior to departure, written cancellations received by Nawas Travel are subject to a 100% cancellation fee of the total tour price per person. Failure to receive final payment by the due date may result in the cancellation of your reservation and the forfeiture of your deposit. Airline tickets are not refundable once issued. No refunds will be given for any unused services while on tour. We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation insurance to allow for any unexpected contingencies. Trip cancellation insurance is available upon written request.

All cabins and categories offered on cruises are subject to availability and are offered on a first-come basis.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE:** Air and land costs are based on estimated 2012 rates using rates of exchange and airfares in effect as of July 11, 2011 and are subject to change. The prices featured are based on a minimum of 21 paying passengers sharing in twin rooms/cabins. Airline space and routing is subject to confirmation. We reserve the right to increase the price of the tour due to any increases in the cruise costs and fuel surcharges that may subsequently occur, or be passed on by NCL Cruises, or due to a major dollar devaluation or a drop in the number of participants. This increase will be collected from each passenger prior to departure.
