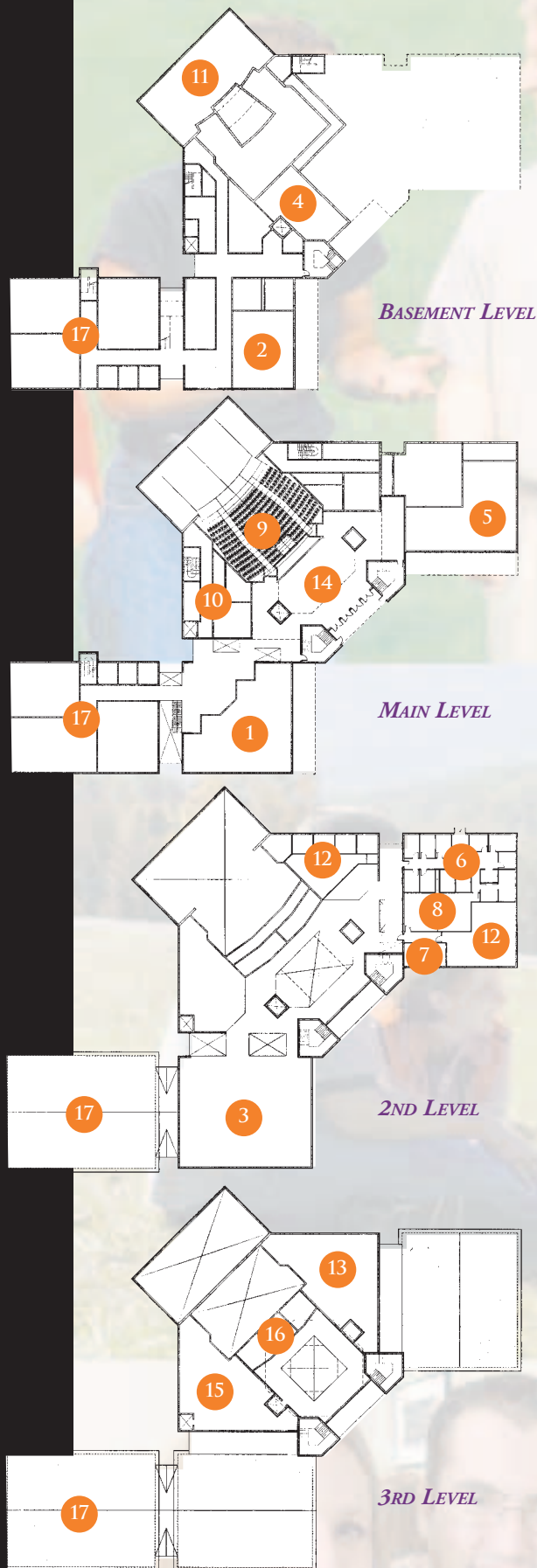
Milligan College is a four-year private Christian liberal arts college in Northeast Tennessee that is consistently named one of "America's Best Colleges" by U.S. News and World Report.

CAMPUS CENTER



Milligan unveiled plans for the new Campus Center in October 2001. The Campus Center will include a Student Center and a Theatre. The building will be located at the site of the current tennis courts, with wings that extend, so as to symbolically welcome people to the Milligan campus. Built in the classical colonial style of other campus buildings, the facility will be a pivotal point for the Milligan community.

STUDENT CENTER

The building is comprised of three main parts. The right and left wings compose the Student Center. The left section is the **Student Life Wing**, which will house the bookstore¹, a wellness center², a dining area and kitchen for the Grill³, and photography darkrooms⁴.

The right section is the **Student Services Wing**, which will house the Student Success Center⁵ and offices for the Student Development staff⁶, Student Government Association⁷, and conference rooms⁸.

THEATRE

The central portion of the building houses a new 300-seat **Theatre**⁹, complete with costume and dressing rooms¹⁰, workshop, storage¹¹, and rehearsal areas. Milligan's performing arts programs are acclaimed for excellence, and this new facility will provide dramatically improved space for practice and performance.

WELCOME AREA

By providing for the relocation of the Admissions Office¹² and the President's Office¹³, the Campus Center will also free additional space in other areas of the campus, most significantly the Welshimer Library. These relocated areas, together with the central lobby¹⁴ and an alumni visitor reception area¹⁵, will help to ensure that the college can more effectively welcome and serve campus visitors. A prayer chapel¹⁶, located in the center section, recognizes the centrality of God's guidance and direction in all of the college's work, and provides an important place for prayer and reflection.

The total cost of the three main sections is an estimated \$12 million. A fourth section¹⁷ represented in the design demonstrates the potential of an academic wing to accommodate future growth.

The Campus Center is part of the larger **Central Campus Project**, which also includes the already completed renovation of Derthick Hall and the development of the campus commons. Together, these additions will enhance the student life and academic experience on campus by centrally locating academic, student life, and administrative areas.
