This course will provide participants with an in-depth knowledge and understanding of the American Occupational Therapy Code of Ethics and the rules and regulations that govern the practice of occupational therapy in Tennessee.

Course Objectives

1. Identify and discuss the standards of practice and core values and attitudes of OT practice.
2. Demonstrate a knowledge and understanding of the American Occupational Therapy Association Code of Ethics (2005).
3. Explain the importance and major types of state law and regulation for OTs and OTAs.
4. Distinguish between the legal requirements of state law regulating OT.
5. Become familiar with the rules that govern to the practice of OT in TN.
