About Shepherd's Inn

The Shepherd's Inn is Elizabethton / Carter County's ONLY emergency shelter for women and their children who are either escaping domestic violence or otherwise homeless--a place of peace and hope...

Since its opening in 1997, The Shepherd's Inn has served nearly 1000 women and their children who have no where and no one to turn. .. Shelter, food, counseling, and other support services are provided 24/7. During the years of operation, over 20,000 meals have been provided.

Funding The Shepherd's Inn is a challenge. The entire budget of \$65,000 is raised from the generosity of community churches, clubs, businesses, individuals, and fund raising events. The city of Elizabethton provides approximately one fifth of the current operational needs. Gifts provide operational support. Also, an endowment has been established where individuals can remember the Inn with bequests, stocks, etc.
