MILLIGAN SCHOLARSHIPS, GRANTS, AND OTHER AID

You are automatically considered for academic merit scholarships as soon as you are admitted.

ACADEMIC MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

- ▶ \$8,850 to \$17,000/year based on ACT/SAT and high school GPA
- Test optional path with scholarships ranging from \$8,000 to \$14,000/year

MILLIGAN GRANTS

- Determined primarily from financial need
- Must complete a FAFSA to be eligible
- Awarded automatically after receipt of FAFSA



OTHER MILLIGAN AID PROGRAMS

JEANES HONORS SCHOLARSHIP

- Two full-tuition scholarships available annually
- Minimum 3.5 GPA and 29 ACT or 1340 SAT

GOAH DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

- ▼ Full-tuition scholarship
- ⊌ Minimum 3.0 GPA and 21 ACT or 1060 SAT

ATHLETIC & OTHER ACTIVITY SCHOLARSHIPS

- Award amounts vary and are determined by the coach/director



NEXT STEPS:

- APPLY TO MILLIGAN. Once admitted, you will receive notification of your academic merit scholarship award.
- FILE YOUR FAFSA beginning in December. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid is used to determine your need-based aid, including the Milligan Grant, Pell Grant, work-study, Tennessee grants, and student loans. File online at studentaid.gov and include Milligan's school code (003511).
- REVIEW & ACCEPT YOUR FINANCIAL AID OFFER. Instructions for accessing and accepting your aid offer will be emailed to admitted students beginning in January. Your offer includes all institutional, state, and federal aid for which you are eligible.
- MANAGE THE BALANCE. All charges are due and payable on the Wednesday before classes begin. The portion not covered by scholarships and awards must be paid in full or on a payment plan by this deadline.
