Jeanes Honors Scholarship

- 2 full-tuition scholarships
- Minimum 3.5 GPA & [29 ACT or 1340 SAT]
- Scholarship application due by Dec. 1

Goah Diversity Scholarship

- 12 full-tuition scholarships
- Minimum 3.0 GPA or [21 ACT or 1060 SAT]
- Scholarship application due by Dec. 1

Academic Merit Scholarships

- \$8,850 to \$17,000/yr based on ACT/SAT & high school GPA
- Test-optional path ranges from \$8,000 to \$14,000/yr
- Automatically awarded at admission

Milligan Grants

- Must complete the FAFSA to be eligible
- Determined by financial need
- Automatically awarded after we receive your FAFSA

Work Study

- 5-10hrs/week on campus

Athletic & Interest Scholarships

Athletic Scholarships

- Award amounts vary as determined by the coach
- May combine with Academic Merit where eligible

Activity & Arts Scholarships

- Honors, art, film, music, theatre, musical theatre, graphic design, disc golf, debate, fly fishing
- May combine with Academic Merit where eligible
- Apply at milligan.edu/aid

Ministry Leadership Program

- Award amounts vary as determined by MLP Director
- May combine with Academic Merit where eligible
- Apply at milligan.edu/aid

ROTC, Military & VA Scholarships

- Army ROTC scholarships up to full tuition
- Yellow Ribbon (must qualify for Post-9/11 GI Bill at the 100% benefit level)

Federal & State Aid

The FAFSA determines eligibility for most financial aid including grants, loans, and Federal Work-Study.

Submit the FAFSA using code 003511 >> studentaid.gov

TN RESIDENTS:

You may also be eligible for the HOPE (Lottery) Scholarship valued up to \$2,250/semester for freshmen and sophomores as well as other TN Aid. List Milligan University as your first choice for the HOPE Scholarship >> collegefortn.org/TSACstudentportal

APPLY TO MILLIGAN. Once admitted, you will receive notification of your academic merit scholarship award.

FILE YOUR FAFSA. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid is used to determine your need-based aid, including the Milligan Grant, Pell Grant, work-study, Tennessee grants, and student loans. File online at fafsa.ed.gov and include Milligan's school code (003511).

REVIEW & ACCEPT YOUR AWARD OFFER.

You will receive your aid offer via email. Soon after, you will also receive a text with a link to a personalized video to help walk you through your offer. This offer will include all institutional, state, and federal aid for which you are eligible.

MANAGE THE BALANCE. All charges are due on the Wednesday before classes begin. The portion not covered by scholarships & aid must be paid in full or through an established payment plan with the Business Office. Milligan offers an interest-free payment plan creating an easy, affordable way to pay the net cost.
