DAY TO DAY ITINERARY

NEW YORK/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

MONDAY, OCT 6

Depart today from New York on board your transatlantic jet flight to Europe. Following a layover, continue your journey to Kenya, arriving the following day.

ARRIVE NAIROBI

TUESDAY, OCT 7

Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport where you will be met and transferred to your hotel. You have arrived in the Heart of Africa to begin one of life's most thrilling and rewarding travel adventures!

NAIROBI/AMBOSELI

WEDNESDAY, OCT 8

This morning drive south over the Athi Plains to Amboseli National Park, justly famous for its big game and its iconic views of Mt. Kilimanjaro. The more than 200 square miles of park embody five main wildlife habitats from the open plains to the massif of Oldonyo Orok at the Western end of the reserve. All of this scenery is dominated by the backdrop of Africa's highest mountain with its permanent snows - Mt. Kilimanjaro - rising to 19,342 feet. After lunch, spend the afternoon on a game drive in search of the big elephant herds and prolific bird life. You will also have the opportunity of viewing other game in the park where numerous species of wildlife abound, including wildebeest, zebra, giraffe, lion, cheetah, and rhino. In the evening, return to the comfort of your Amboseli Lodge. (B,L,D)

AMBOSELI - MT. KILIMANJARO

THURSDAY, OCT 9

Start the day with a dawn game drive to catch the earliest of risers in this beautiful park. Early morning is also the best chance to view and photograph the peaks of the tallest mountain in Africa, Mt. Kilimanjaro, before the clouds build up over the summit in the midday heat. After lunch continue on your afternoon game drive in the Amboseli National Park as this is the best time of day to see lion and cheetah as they begin to stir from the shade and roam onto the plains in search of a kill. Overnight at your Amboseli Lodge. (B,L,D)



AMBOSELI/ABERDARE NATIONAL PARK

FRIDAY, OCT 10

After an early breakfast we will have a long drive north to the Aberdare Country Club. We will make a stop en route in Nairobi where we will have lunch. Continue through Kikuyu country via Thika, the setting for Elspeth Huxley's "The Flame Trees of Thika" to Aberdare National Park. Overnight at your Aberdare Lodge with fabulous viewing decks over a floodlit waterhole with salt licks which attract a host of fabulous wildlife. Here you may view elephant, buffalo and several species of antelope that come to drink. In addition to the views from your room and decks, there is also a unique ground level bunker for close-up photography. (B,L,D)



ABERDARE NATIONAL PARK/SAMBURU

SATURDAY, OCT 11

After breakfast we drive north across the Equator headed to Samburu Sopa Lodge in time for lunch. After lunch embark on an afternoon game drive. Samburu has a more arid climate, with different colors and hues in the landscape palette and is famed for its rare and distinctive northern species of giraffe and zebra. You will also

be able to photograph the local animal species as our lodge sits atop high ground allowing for panoramic views. (B,L,D)

SAMBURU

SUNDAY, OCT 12

Today you will embark on morning and afternoon game drives in Samburu searching for the unique reticulated giraffe, beisa oryx Grevy's zebra, Somali ostrich and the graceful long-necked gerenuk. After lunch continue on the game drive and then visit a Samburu village for a first hand experience where you will meet the most colorful and photogenic people of Kenya. After a long day, we return to our lodge and leisurely savor the natural beauty of East Africa. (B,L,D)



SAMBURU/MOUNT KENYA/OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY MONDAY, OCT 13

Leave Samburu this morning and drive to the Ol Pejeta Conservancy a wildlife refuge situated on the equator west of Nanyuki in the foothills of the Aberdares and Mount Kenya. Lunch will be at Sweetwaters Serena Camp, with views across the plains to Mount Kenya and its tallest peak at over 17,000 feet. After lunch continue on an afternoon game drive in the Ol Pejeta Conservancy with Mt Kenya in the background including visits to largest black rhino sanctuary and home to two of the world's last remaining white rhino. Overnight in Ol Pejeta Conservancy. (B,L,D)

OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY/LAKE NAIVASHA TUESDAY, OCT 14

Today get up early for a full day of activity. You will drive into the Great Rift Valley with your first stop at Thomson's waterfalls on the Ewaso Ng'iro River in the Central Rift Valley to view one of Kenya's highest waterfalls. Then drive to Lake Naivasha Sopa Lodge for lunch. In the afternoon take a boat ride on Lake Naivasha followed by a guided bush walk on the famous Crescent Island which rose to fame after the 1985 movie "Out of Africa". Here you may walk among giraffe, zebra and antelope and you may see warthogs and wildebeest in their natural habitat. (B,L,D)



LAKE NAIVASHA/MASAI MARA WEDNESDAY, OCT 15

After breakfast, drive to the great Masai Mara Game Reserve the most favored park in all of Kenya. The famous Masai Mara is at the northern point of Serengeti. It is renowned for its abundant wildlife including prides of

lions, leopards, cheetah, hyena elephant buffaloes zebra, giraffe, wildebeest and more! It is the Africa of our imagination: endless reaches of acacia-dotted grasslands. Following lunch you will take your first game drive in this remarkable reserve. Return to your lodge for a delicious dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)



MASAI MARA

THURSDAY, OCT 16

Everything is big in the Masai Mara Reserve, from the herds of zebra and wildebeest, which originate in the Serengeti, to the many prides of the mighty lion that rest and laze in the shade. The full day game drives includes carrying a picnic lunch. The driver will point out the sights that his trained eyes see, long before we do. You will also visit the Mara River to search for hippo and crocodile. Return to your lodge for dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)

MASAI MARA/NAIROBI

FRIDAY, OCT 17

After breakfast you will leave the Masai Mara and start the long drive back to Nairobi. Overnight at your Nairobi Hotel. (B)

NAIROBI/EUROPE

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 18

Today is free for last minute shopping and exploring on your own. Evening flight to Europe.

EUROPE/NEW YORK

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 19

Continue today on your flight back to New York, arriving the same day.
